**We cordially invite you to the press preview of the exhibitions “Mark Bradford. Keep Walking” and “Museum in Motion. A Collection for the 21st Century” on Wednesday, September 4, 2024, 11 am at Hamburger Bahnhof.**

On September 6 the Hamburger Bahnhof will celebrate the reopening of the Rieckhallen, following the acquisition of this unique space by the state of Berlin in November 2022 and its permanent preservation for the public. The front section of the Rieckhallen will feature temporary special exhibitions over an area of around 1,300 square meters, while the rear section will showcase contemporary art from the Nationalgalerie's collection, spanning approximately 1,500 square meters. This will include works from the new cooperation with the Federal Art Collection and recent donations. The exhibition "Museum in Motion. A Collection for the 21st Century" will display around 10 large scale installations, media art, and other works, completing the Hamburger Bahnhof's presentation of art from 1989 to the present. Featured artists include Elmgreen & Dragset, Cevdet Erek, Anne Imhof, Jeremy Shaw, and Jasmin Werner. The inaugural special exhibition "Mark Bradford. Keep Walking" in the newly reopened Rieckhallen will be the first institutional solo exhibition in Germany by the American artist Mark Bradford, showcasing large scale paintings, sculptures, and video installations that address themes such as race, gender, and economic inequality. Additionally, the new Rieckhallen studio will offer workshops for groups and serve as an open space for individual visitors.
