“In Conversation”: popular talk series with international artists continues for two more years; admission is free

For two more years, Hamburger Bahnhof remains in conversation with artists and audiences: The opening event of the now third edition of the free talk series “In Conversation. A Series in Cooperation with Deutsche Bank” will feature Thomas Struth on 28 February 2026. In March, Kader Attia follows, and in April Joana Hadjithomas & Khalil Joreige will speak about their art. In May, Lina Lapelyté continues the series on the occasion of her solo exhibition at Hamburger Bahnhof. Admission to all events is free.

At the same time, the cooperation with Deutsche Bank is being continued. In the monthly format “In Conversation. A Series in Cooperation with Deutsche Bank”, artists speak about their work. Since February 2024, Hamburger Bahnhof has invited international artists to engage in conversation with the public. Established artists discuss their beginnings, their development, the Berlin art scene in an international context, and share their perspectives on the future of artistic practice.
