We cordially invite you to the press conference of the exhibition *Brancusi* on Tuesday, 17 March 2026, 11 am at Neue Nationalgalerie.

From 20 March to 9 August 2026, the Neue Nationalgalerie in Berlin is presenting in cooperation with the Centre Pompidou in Paris a major solo exhibition dedicated to the Romanian-French sculptor Constantin Brancusi (1876–1957). Featuring more than 150 works, it will be the first comprehensive exhibition of this exceptional artist in Germany in over 50 years. The exhibition is held under the joint patronage of Frank-Walter Steinmeier, President of the Federal Republic of Germany, Emmanuel Macron, President of the French Republic and Nicușor Dan, President of Romania.

In addition to key works such as *Sleeping Muse*, *The Kiss*, *Bird in Space*, and *Endless Column*, the exhibition also features a partial reconstruction of Brancusi's legendary studio. This ensemble is considered key to understanding his work, a laboratory of form and direct testimony to his creative process. It will be shown outside of Paris for the first time.
